Museums and Attractions

Family Attractions:

- The Children's Museum
 - The largest children's museum in the world, and named one of the best by Child magazine, offers interactive exhibits exploring art, science, history and culture, a Dinosphere, and planetarium. Over one million visitors each year enjoy this five-level playground with a 43-foot brightly colored Dale Chihuly 'Fireworks of Glass' sculpture hanging in the middle and a fully rideable antique carousel on the top floor.

 - o Admission: \$12-\$35. Prices vary daily.
- White River State Park
 - As America's only cultural urban state park, White River State Park offers more than 250 acres of green space filled with an array of cultural attractions, public art, and entertainment. Explore the park by bike, Segway, or your own two feet as you go door-to-door at some if Indy's finest attractions including the Indianapolis Zoo, Eiteljorg Museum of American Indians and Western Art, NCAA Hall of Champions, Indiana State Museum, and Victory Field.

- Indianapolis Zoo
 - O Walk with the flamingos, go face-to-face with a tiger, touch a shark the unique animal encounters available for everyone make the Indianapolis Zoo a must on your Indianapolis list. With five different animal habitat biomes to explore, guests will enjoy their visit year round, no matter what the weather is like outside. The Zoo is also home to the world's largest Orangutan Center.

- Indianapolis Motor Speedway
 - Take an IndyCar, pace car, or shuttle tour around the iconic 2.5-mile Indianapolis Motor Speedway that welcomes 300,000 visitors each May, the Indy 500, is the ultimate family experience. Inside the oval is the Hall of Fame Museum, housing memorabilia, trophies and winning cars from the past century of open-wheel racing that will have your kids itching for a Matchbox car upgrade.

- Indiana State Museum
 - Explore Indiana from the beginning of time through culture and science at the Indiana State Museum. Kids will find hands-on areas throughout most exhibits that really allow them to dig into real life history. Along the exterior of the museum, your family will discover artworks representing the 92 counties that make up the great state of Indiana.

- Soldiers and Sailors Monument / Monument Circle
 - o The monument is located on Monument Circle in the center of downtown and has come to symbolize the city of Indianapolis and the state of Indiana. Designed by Bruno Schmitz and constructed between 1887 and 1902, this limestone monument includes sculptures by Rudolf Schwartz (who created the figures on the structure's sides), George Brewster (who created the figure of Victory that caps the monument, as well as two astragals) and Nicolaus Geiger (who created the Army astragal).

Entertainment

Breweries:

- Indy Beer Mile (Tour)
 - Craft beer connoisseurs and casual beer drinkers alike will discover different beer styles from around the world during this walkable beer tour along the Cultural Trail in the trendy Mass Ave District. Visit 4-5 local establishments and learn the origin of beer while sampling.

- Indiana City Brewing Company
 - Indiana City enjoys creating innovative brews based on traditional styles using their small-batch, hand-crafted approach. The brewery is located in the historic 'Bottling House' of the Home Brewing Company on the east side of downtown.

- Black Circle Brewing Company
 - Black Circle focuses on quality local craft offerings and brewing our own ultra smallbatch versions of their favorite beer styles. A full menu is always available, whether you visit for the brews, live music, movies, or other entertainment. Don't forget your quarters for the vintage arcade games.

- Rock Bottom Restaurant and Brewery
 - O While Rock Bottom may be a chain restaurant, the brews are independently created at each locale. With a philosophy that beer should be clean, simple, and fresh, it's no surprise that the brewery has won a few awards through the years!

- Cannon Ball Brewing Company
 - Just east of downtown, this nanobrewery is a modern take on the neighborhood bar.
 Housed in a century-old building that was once the neighborhood grocery, Cannon Ball offers an ever-changing selection of brews and a unique menu of locally-sourced small plate food.

Shopping:

Circle Center

- Shopping at a mall in Indy has a local tie-in. The city's premier destinations are owned by Indy's Simon Property Group, the world's largest mall operator. Circle Centre, contained inside two blocks' worth of old and new buildings downtown, is connected to several hotels and the Indiana Convention Center. Convention attendees can easily fit in shopping sprees during breaks and the massive food court is perfect for a quick (and affordable) bite to eat.
