- A signed copy of the NASBLA Terms & Conditions document.
- A copy of the Paddlesports Course Certificate of Completion. If the course is sanctioned by NASBLA, you will be given authorization to display the NASBLA-Sanctioned Paddlesports Logo. In addition, the certificate must include the following words: "This course is Sanctioned by NASBLA and recognized by the USCG."
- List the title and producer of any videos used in the course. You may need to submit a copy of the item(s) if NASBLA does not already have a copy on file.
